Horsley, Bookham and Leatherhead RDA supports 120 children, provinding 1750 rides a year. In 2021 we broke ground, having the fantastic opportunity to build a purpose built indoor riding facility. Our new arena started hosting riding sessions in Spring 2022 and will be officially opened in September 2022.

Our ambition is to continue with our expansion plans and increase our rider numbers to over 180 children and young adults, addressing our longstanding waiting list of potetial riders.
